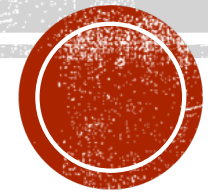

IMPORTANT INFORMATION



1. Email [Steven Lappert](#) immediately after winning your state tournament with the name of your Little League, state, tournament record, and primary contact.
2. Submit your roster via email. Forms are available through this link: [Online Forms](#)
3. Bring your team State Championship banner with you to the tournament. We will have an Opening Night parade prior to our tournament banquet.
4. The tournament is scheduled to be in a double-elimination format, and the complete schedule is available online on the [tournament website](#). All games will be played at the host site, Dover Little League.
5. Transportation to and from the tournament, and lodging during the tournament, are the responsibility of the travelling teams.
6. Bring your tournament affidavit and paperwork documentation to complex prior to the Opening Ceremony for review.
7. All managers are expected to attend the manager's meeting at Dover Little League on Wednesday, July 16th at 7:15pm. At least one member of the coaching staff of each team must be present, but all coaches are encouraged to attend. No players or guests will be admitted.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION



7. Opening Night Banquet: On Wednesday, July 16th at 6:00pm, Dover Little League will host an Opening Night BBQ banquet for the teams. There will be no charge to managers, coaches, players, and family members under 5 years of age. Parents and friends are welcome to attend with a \$10 charge.
8. Each player and coach will also get a meal voucher for each day that they are scheduled to play. Lunch, beverages, and ice cream will be provided to them as our way of thanking everyone for their participation in this year's tournament.
9. Dover Little League runs a full-service concession stand with restaurant quality food. Breakfast and lunch will be available daily at reasonable prices.
10. The facility is a smoke-free and alcohol-free site. Alcohol and smoking are not permitted at any time at the facility or parking lots.
11. Managers and coaches may wear full uniforms. For those not in uniform, managers and coaches must wear short-sleeve shirts with collars. Instead of uniform pants, managers and coaches may wear long casual pants or shorts. Jeans, sweatpants, and cargo shorts are not permitted. Athletic shoes or sneakers may be worn. Metal spikes and sandals are not permitted.
12. A throat guard must be worn, this includes infield warm-up and in the bullpen.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION



12. Each team is required to have in their possession a Medical Release Form for each player on their affidavit. The form must be signed by a parent or guardian.
13. Tournament team conduct shall be above reproach. The use of air horns, cow bells, or other types of excessive noise making items are prohibited. This also means cheering/jeering while the pitcher is in motion. Managers are not only responsible for their players and coaches, but also for the conduct of their fans.
14. Uniforms and equipment will be the responsibility of the participating teams. All equipment will be Little League approved or meet Little League specifications.
15. There will be no pre-game equipment check by umpires. Sole responsibility for legal and proper equipment falls entirely on the team manager.
16. All batting helmets must meet NOCSAE specifications, bear NOCSAE stamp, and have an exterior warning label.
17. Ensure that all players and coaches have travel documents in their possession in the event that they travel from Dover to the Little League Intermediate World Series. The winner of our tournament advances to the tournament in Livermore, California! The travel date for the winner of the tournament is **Friday, July 25th**.



GAME DAY



Day of game instructions

- Teams should arrive to the facility at least one hour prior to their scheduled game.
- Dugout assignments: The team listed on the top of the bracket occupies the first base dugout. The team listed on the bottom occupies the third base dugout.
- All fields are considered neutral.
 - The tournament director will flip a coin prior to the game.
 - The manager of the team in the third base dugout will call the toss.
 - The winner of the coin toss will choose to be the home or away team.
- One hour before game: Managers check in with tournament director and flip coin.
- Pre-game warm-ups
 - Team listed first on the bracket has the field for 20 minutes, beginning 55 minutes before game time.
 - Team listed second on the bracket has the field for 20 minutes, beginning 35 minutes before game time.
 - The team that does not have the field has access to the batting cage during that time.
 - These times may be shortened to stay within the scheduled game times.
- Teams will meet at home plate 15 minutes prior to the game to discuss ground rules with the tournament director and umpires.

GAME SITE AND FACILITIES

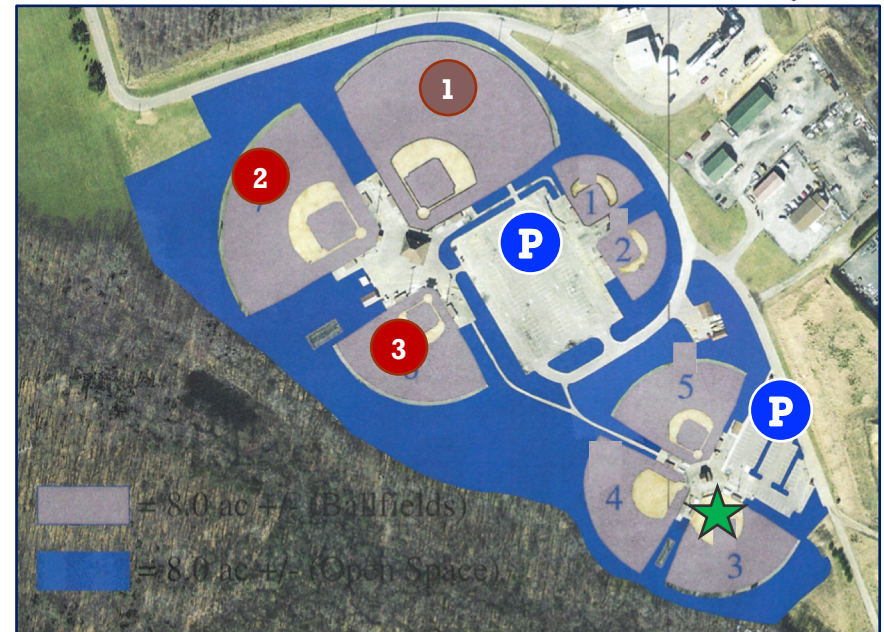
Fields 2 and 3 serve as Dover Little League's Intermediate 50/70 fields, and both fields will be used to host the East Regional tournament. Be sure to check your schedule to find the correct field.

For teams arriving early for their scheduled games, ample warm-up space is available. We can schedule other fields for practice.

Batting cages are available between fields 2 and 3.

The complex has a large parking lot adjacent to the fields. The league also has additional parking at the softball complex lots next door.

The concession stand and public restrooms are located at the intersection of fields 1, 2, and 3.
